

Public Affairs Code of Conduct

1. Introduction & Purpose

The purpose of this Code is to ensure that all lobbying activities conducted by Attis and Attis Partner Paul Barnes and any colleagues are transparent, ethical, and professional. We are committed to maintaining the integrity of the UK political process.

2. Transparency & Identity

Full Disclosure: We will always identify ourselves by name and disclose the identity of the client we represent before engaging in any communication with a public official.

Accurate Information: We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that the information we provide to public officials is accurate, up-to-date, and not misleading.

3. Integrity & Professionalism

No Financial Inducements: We will never offer or give any financial or other incentive (gifts, hospitality, or favors) to a public official that could be construed as an attempt to exert improper influence.

Conflict of Interest: We will actively avoid any conflict of interest. If a conflict arises between the interests of different clients or between a client and our firm, we will disclose it immediately and take steps to resolve it or withdraw from the representation.

4. Compliance with Law

Statutory Registration: We will remain fully compliant with the Transparency of Lobbying, Non-Party Campaigning and Trade Union Administration Act 2014.

Quarterly Returns: We commit to filing accurate quarterly information returns to the ORCL within the required deadlines.

5. Confidentiality

While maintaining transparency with the government, we will protect the confidential information of our clients and former clients, provided such confidentiality does not conflict with legal disclosure requirements.
